Alexandre Poncet, 49, has been appointed Limagrain's VP of International Public and Governmental Affairs.

He and his team will be responsible for developing a robust strategy to ensure Limagrain's voice is heard in the European Commission and Parliament. He will support the Group's subsidiaries in Europe to enhance their influence on their respective home-country governments. At the same time, he will ensure Limagrain is properly represented by and aligned with the professional associations advocating for the seed, agri-food and farming cooperative sectors. Alexandre will also continue to oversee institutional relations with French government bodies both nationally and in the Rhône-Alpes-Auvergne region.

Alexandre will therefore play a key role in furthering Limagrain's long-term growth and contributing to our Ambition 2030 strategic plan."

Alexandre previously served as Limagrain's Chief Communication and Public Affairs Officer. Before joining the Group, he worked at Coca-Cola Europacific Partners, Schlumberger, Usinor and the FACE foundation (Fondation Agir Contre l'Exclusion). He is a graduate of Sciences Po Paris and earned a master's degree in Labor Law and Human Resources Management from the University of Paris II (CIFFOP). He completed the prestigious CHEDE training program offered by the Institute for Public Management and Economic Development, the training arm of France's economic and financial ministries.
